SCIENCE FAIR AND POSTER PUB

Every afternoon (14.00 – 17.30) during the Science Symposium (April 14-16) there will be a Science Fair. It includes a unique 'smorgasbord' of different activities of your own choice: panels, working groups, poster pub, speed talks, stand up science and music. During the Science Fair you will also have the opportunity to test new video conferencing technology supplied by the Centre for Sustainable Communications at the Royal Institute of Technology (KTH) in Stockholm.



RESILIENCE ART EXHIBITION

Sustaining and developing social capacity will be a prerequisite for resilience, adaptability and transformability. To explore this fundamentally important feature and to complement and enhance the scientific symposium, there will be a Resilience Art Exhibition in connection with the conference, with jury-selected works. The exhibition is a joint project of the Royal Academy of Fine Arts (through Mejan Labs in Stockholm) and the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences (through the Beijer Institute and the Stockholm Resilience Centre) in collaboration with the Resilience Alliance.
